MAKE DREAMS A REALITY

A new chapter in Indian Sports History has been scripted with the winning of a gold medal by Abhinav Bindra at the Beijing Olympics. It is more than just a historic feat- it is a miraculous story of grit and determination.

With a spine injury hampering his preparations in the run up to the Games, he was best given an outside chance. A spine injury meant that even lifting a rifle was out of question and murmurs started as to whether the prodigious talent would ever be at his best.

However, Bindra returned to the shooting range after almost one year of a gruelling rehab. Fitter and more determined, Bindra made sure that his third attempt at Olympic glory went perfectly by the script. In a thriller of a contest that went right down to the last shot, Bindra beat off competition from a reigning Olympic champion enroute to his historic feat which would be celebrated for a long time to come.

He has been dreaming about the Olympic gold for the last ten years. "An Olympic medal is my goal and I will not be satisfied till I get it." These were his words. This obsession fetched the reticent twenty-five year old a gold medal in the men's 10m air rifle shooting contest in Beijing.

A country with brilliant people deserves many more gold medals. If talent is recognized early, proper infrastructure is provided and proper training given without any bias, then we are sure that sportspersons like Vijender Singh and Sushil Kumar would hog the limelight with gold medals.

We hope that the euphoria generated by these three sportsmen will not die down and at the next Olympics India will bring home more medals, glitz, glamour and glory.
