## **KOLA PERUMAL CHETTY VAISHNAV SENIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL**

### **HISTORY OF THE SCHOOL**

The Vallabhacharya Vidya Sabha, dedicated to the cause of Education started its second phase of meritorious work with the establishment of a first class English Medium School where the most modern techniques and training are cohered, with the highest principles of Hindu religion and culture. The School flourished under the patronage of its great benefactor, Shri Kola Perumal Chetty, who was the embodiment of simplicity and generosity. Truly altruistic in his outlook, he came forward with a generous donation of Rs.4 lakhs which included 21 grounds of land very close to the Vaishnav College Campus. Thus with the blessings of His Holiness 108 Goswami Shri Brijrathnalaji Maharaj, the Kola Perumal Chetty Vaishnav Senior Secondary School came into existence on July 3rd 1972. As a landmark of the Silver Jubilee Celebrations, Pre-KG classes started and the Kola Perumal Chetty Vaishnav Balalaya was born with classes from Pre KG to Upper KG. It is well equipped with play materials, audiovisual aids, playground, an auditorium and a canteen.

### **AIMS AND OBJECTIVES**

The School was founded by a Society deeply attached to Hindu Religion and thought. It will, therefore, be the endeavour of the Management to maintain an atmosphere of intense devotion to HINDU Religion in the campus even while inculcating in the wards, love and respect for other religions. The School

which derives its inspiration from Hindu Philosophy, Literature and Culture, tries to integrate these values with the cosmopolitan outlook of a good English Public School.

The Management and the teachers have set for themselves an ambitious goal of creating a strong younger generation with a sound mind in a sound body. They realized that a mere formal education is too deficient to achieve this end. To develop personality, high values and good habits in the students, the School lays stress on the following:

- (i) The guru-sishya tradition of yore.
- (ii) Providing child centered education.
- (iii) Building up of child's confidence.
- (iv) Development of leadership qualities.
- (v) Enhancing motor development.
- (vi) Sharing and caring for others.

### **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**

The medium of instruction in all classes is English. Hindi and Tamil are taught in U.K.G.

### **ADMISSION**

I. The School year is divided into four terms - May to July, August to October, November to January and February to April.

2. A child seeking admission has to be registered first by paying

a fee of Rs.200/-. Thereafter he / she is admitted to the class after a formal meeting with her parents. Application for admission should be made in the prescribed form by the Parents / Guardian of the child.

3. In no case will admission be granted as a matter of course. The Principal reserves the right to refuse admission without assigning any reason whatsoever.

4. Students seeking admission to Pre KG should complete 2½ years and to LKG, should complete 3½ years by June 1st of the academic year. A student seeking admission into the Pre-KG or LKG class should produce in original the following certificates at the time of admission :

- a) Birth Certificate
- b) Community Certificate - attested copy to be submitted
- c) Health Certificate including Blood Group.

5. Change of address form available in the school office. Parents are requested to avail this as and when there is change of residence

#### **SCHOOL FEES**

1. After the final selection of candidate, the fee should be remitted in the School Office as per Schedule and the receipt should be obtained for the same.

Thereafter the fee is payable only by Cheque/Draft in the Canara Bank situated in the campus of Dwaraka Doss Goverdhan Doss Vaishnav College. The Fee Challan Booklet

#### **The dates for payment of term fees are as under:**

- a. From 1 to 10 April / August / November / February  
No fine.
  - b. From 11 to 15 April/August/November/February - with a fine of Rs. 20/-
  - c. After 16 April / August / November / February the student's name will be struck off from the rolls.
2. If the dates mentioned above happen to be holidays for the school or Bank, the fees have to be paid on the preceding working day.
3. Cheques on local banks or demand drafts will be accepted by the Canara Bank from 1 to 10 April/August November / February.
4. All kinds of fees (Terms, Examination, Coaching Class, etc..) must be paid in the School Office or through the Bank as applicable. Under no circumstances, should fees be sent through any employee of the School.

#### **SPECIAL FEATURES**

##### **A. INTENSIVE ACADEMIC TRAINING**

1. The Montessori method of teaching is followed in the Pre - KG. Stress is laid on the playway and activity oriented methods. Children learn through songs, rhymes, stories, dramas, puppet shows, etc. Arts and crafts are also a part of the curriculum. A free atmosphere is created for children to explore and learn.

2. The Phonetic method of teaching is followed in LKG and UKG. The School has adopted the sound system which enables the child to read any word. The new system is taught to them through phonetic drill, games and flash cards.

#### **B. DIARY**

The school diary is an important link between the home and the school. Parents should check it everyday and see that it is brought to school daily by the students.

#### **C. SPORTS AND GAMES**

Drill and physical training are compulsory components of the curriculum.

#### **D. FIELD TRIPS**

Students are taken on field trips every term to enable them to learn through observation and personal experience.

#### **E. PRAYER**

The tone of the school is set by the prayer which commences at 8-30 a.m. on all the working days.

#### **F. AUDITORIUM**

The school functions are held in the New ADC open air auditorium and in the school prayer hall.

#### **G. CANTEEN**

The school has a canteen which provides hygienic eatables at reasonable prices.

#### **H. MEDICAL FACILITIES :**

The school runs a first aid cell. Annual medical check-ups done by qualified doctors, is a must for every student.

#### **I. PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION :**

An active P.T.A. meets once every term to discuss the various problems faced by them. But its executive body meets more frequently to discuss issues connected with the school.

#### **J. BOOKSTALL**

The school has a well equipped book stall which supplies books and stationery to the students as per their requirements. This is beneficial to both students and parents.

#### **K. CLASS LIBRARY :**

Each class has many sets of beautiful attractive picture books to inculcate the habit of viewing and handling books for pleasure. Immense joy is experienced by the tiny tots as they go through these colourful books.

#### **L. PLAY GROUND :**

A playground with swing, jungle - jim, see - saw, merry-go-round, slide etc. enable the children to play freely. They are also provided with a wide variety of toys to play indoors.

#### **M. AUDIO - VISUAL AIDS :**

The teaching - learning process is done through audio - visual aids. A Television, Video Cassette Player, Tape Recorder and Radio are provided.

**N. INTERNET :**

The school also has an internet connection to help teachers keep abreast with the times.

**SCHOOL BUS :**

A school bus was purchased in 2002 to provide easy and safe transport to the young students living at a distance from the school. Parents are requested to utilize this facility for the safety of their wards.

**P. Audio Visual Room :**

A new audio visual room was constructed in 2005 for the benefit of the students.

**WITH DRAWALS :**

1. Applications for T.C. must be given in writing by the Parent / Guardian, in case of need, before March 31st, of every year. The T.C. is made ready after the results of that year are announced. It should be collected before April 7 failing which the application for T.C. gets lapsed. Application for issue of T.C. received after the announcement of the results (March 31) will be entertained only after the payment of fees for one term.
2. If the applications are made after March 31st the T.C. will only be issued one week after the school reopens i.e. in June.
3. In case where the T.C. is applied one year or more after leaving the school, a search fee of Rs. 25/- will be collected.
4. Duplicate T.C.s are not normally issued. However, the Principal reserves the right to issue one if convinced of the genuineness of the case. Rs. 100/- is levied in such cases.
